I. World Creativity and Innovation Day is celebrated on 21st of April every year. OUTBI and CCE have directed EDC to observe Innovation Day under the banner *T-Innovation Mahotsavam* by engaging students in an activity-based workshop followed by Essay Writing Competitions.

About 75 students participated in the activity and 17 in Essay writing.

Preparation of mobile stand with paper: Members of EDC of VGDC facilitated the activity and students enjoyed making mobile stands with paper and came up with different models of stands and other creative models using paper.

3. EDC- YFSI Orientation- CCE initiated UNICEF sponsored 'Youth for Social Impact' programme supported by T-Hub and V-Hub of Telangana state to nurture ideas in youth for a start-up. The ideas were invited from all institutions of Telangana and students had to register in teams with a pilot(leader) and crew (members). An orientation to all students was given as per CCE guidelines and the students were apprised of the benefits of the programme to work in a team.

Orientation was conducted twice, FN for BSC and AN for Arts and Commerce on 24th of May 2022. About 181 students attended the sessions and faculty facilitated team formation.

Students evinced interest in joining the online workshop for a week and have registered their names on the YFSI portal. About 61 students in 26 teams got registered and started their online modules from 28th May 2022. A WhatsApp group was created for the registered students and updates, alerts were posted in the group.

Student registrations completed by 30th may and teams completed their first Module, Pre-Assessment survey, Module 2, 3 and have submitted their idea on YFSI portal. Last date was extended to August 30th as most of the students couldn't access post- submission essay.

Out of 26 teams 8 teams completed the modules, submitted their ideas.

However VGDC teams couldn't get shortlisted for next phase.
