



1. Telangana Formation Day- June 2nd, 2023

As part of Telangana Dashabdi Utsavaalu, a decade of Telangana formation, the college conducted various competitions on Telanagana History, culture, language and literature. Prizes were distributed after the unfurling of National flag and singing Telangana state song.








2. One Day Teacher Training Workshop on Autonomy @ GDCW (A), Begumpet-July 19, 2023

VGDC had applied for Fresh autonomous status as it was awarded with A Grade in 2nd cycle of NAAC accreditation. The IQAC committee members, ACO, Autonomy committee members attended the one day workshop with hands on training on drafting Academic Council, BoS, Finance Committee. IQAC presented a rough draft of academic council at the end of the workshop. About 5 teachers participated in the workshop.









Outcome: The IQAC, ACO, Autonomy team understood the basics of implementation fresh autonomous status with latest guidelines of UGC. And it was found necessary to organise such workshop for all the teachers of VGDC.

3. Samskruti Foundation- Rakhi for Soldiers- 3rd August, 2023

Samskruti Foundation, collected Rakhis to be distributed to soldiers at the border. VGDC students prepared Rakhis and handed them over to the organisers. About 20 students and 4 faculty members participated in the event.





4. Pravah Closure MLMF August 11, 2023

Pravah, partner NGO has conducted workshops for students of VGDC under MLMF-My Life, Mere Faisle, in two phases training about 70 students in resolving relationship issues through healthy dialogue and compassion. The scheme came to a closure and a photo exhibition followed by final youth adda workshop, certificate distribution, launch of SMILE programe was conducted. About 42 students from batch 2, and 28 from batch 1 received certificates.












5. Independence Day August 15, 2023



6. Samaarambham- Orientation to First Year Students in 3 phases-Aug 17th to

VGDC conducted an Induction/orientation to all the first year students in two phases. First phase for all BSC, both Life Science and Physical Science along with BCA students. Second phase orientation was conducted in three sessions: two for BCOM and one for BBA and BA. Students were introduced to all the departments, faculty and office staff. They were apprised of code of conduct, Anti ragging Policy, CBCS pattern, semester details, examination pattern, internals, assignments, various facilities available, committees, clubs and cells in college, certificate courses and importance of WhatsApp groups. Their doubts were answered by faculty.









Leo Club Unit of VGDC coordinated by NSS Program Officer Dr.J. Chinna Babu later motivated students to join LEO club and the event was also attended by Leo Club Hyderabad office members. Outcome: Students volunteered to join NSS, Leo Club, and various clubs and committees of college.

VGDC participated in the telecast and the students were oriented on various phases of the mission. About **60** Students joined the countdown and recorded on their mobile phones the successful landing of Vikram Rover. The success of ISRO was celebrated by sweet distribution.

9. Blood Donation Drive-

IQAC facilitated Blood Donation drive in Campus organised by NSS unit 1 and 2 in collaboration with Institute of Preventive Medicine(IPM), Govt of Telangana on 21st of September, 2023. Blood donation was initiated by Principal herself followed by students and staff. About **35** students donated blood and received Appreciation certificates from IPM.









10.Bathukamma Competitions sponsored by Malabar Gold

Telangana State Festival Bathukamma is celebrated every year in a grand manner. In 2023-2024, Malabar Gold, Himayatnagar Branch sponsored prizes to Best Bathukamma preparation accompanied by traditional song and dance in groups. All the 17 departments of VGDC participated with their students and prizes were awarded. There was a special prize for a Bathukamma prepared by boys. About 40 teachers and 130 students actively participated.

12. Science Exhibition:

On National Science Day, the departments of Sciences, both Physical and Life sciences organised an exhibition of models, posters, slides, Rangoli with science concepts and as an ISR activity invited neighbouring Junior College and SVES School students to create scientific temperament and inculcate an interest to take up pure sciences. Stalls were set up in labs, corridors and students of Life Sciences even displayed their stall of herbal products prepared after certificate course that staff of school and colleges purchased.

About 60 students participated in exhibition visited by 180 students of school and Junior college.


Judges were invited to judge best poster, best model, best exhibit and prizes were announced.

The Resource Person trained the staff in constituting their respective Boards of Studies, new rules, meetings, minutes, examination patterns; autonomy in 80:20 ratio or 70:30 ratio, designing curriculum, certificate courses, Impotant bodies in Autonomy like Academic Coordinator, Examination Branch, Roles and Responsibilities of Controller of Examinations, Additional Controllers, Academic Coordinators, General Body Meetings; Financial Committee; Department level preparation. Templates were shared with staff memmbers. Departments expressed confidence in preparing their respective BOS.

Feedback: The staff were satisfied with the workshop as they felt confident and aware of the stages involved in constituting Boards of Studies, selecting members, Nominating Panel of Examiners. The workshop fulfilled its objective of providing hands on training in Implementation of Fresh Autonomous status.

Outcome: The departments drafted their BOS teams and contacted Osmania University Nominees to take implement autonomy from the academic year 2024-2025.

Physics and Mathematics organised by Department of Physics and Department of Mathematics on April 19th and 20th 2024. The Seminar was funded by TSCHE- Telangana State Council for Higher Education, Government of Telangana. The Seminar had parallel sessions both online and offline and had Plenary sessions by eminent speakers followed by technical sessions. The convenors received 120 research papers from scholars including students. The 2 day deliberations discussed recent advances in fields of Physics and Mathematics.
